


Beyond Digital Literacy

Item Formats

- Selected Response
 - Assessment items where students select from a given set of response options
- Constructed Response/Extended Response
 - Assessment items where students produce the response instead of selecting from a list
- Performance Tasks
 - Assessment items where students perform a skill or create a product
- Technology-Enhanced / Technology-Enabled
 - Assessment items that leverage the interactive features of computer technology.


- □ Grade 3 ELA Time length 60 to 90 minutes over two days
- □ Grade 4-7 ELA Time length -- 90 to 120 minutes over two days
- □ Grade 8-11 ELA Time length 180 minutes over three days

Performance Task Specs Guidelines

- Across multiple standards
- Measure depth of knowledge, research
- Evidence-based, text-dependent analysis
- Reflect real world or scenario-based problem
- Allow for multiple approaches, interpretations
- 21st century skills (critical analysis and synthesis of information presented in variety of formats)

Differences in Common Core Assessments

- 1. Short, medium and long writing
- 2. Writing and technology-embedded ways to demonstrate understanding
- 3. Toward non-fiction, information texts
- 4. Focus on argument, close reading, authors intent and rhetorical moves
- 5. Text complexity
- 6. Speaking and listening incorporated


